You may remember that in 2007 we got a scheme turned down for the REDEVELOPMENT OF THE BUILDINGS AT THE GOODGE STREET AND TOTTENHAM COURT ROAD CORNER.

Recently, a new and equally damaging proposal has been put in for planning permission.

It again involves the demolition of no. 1-3 Goodge Street - only keeping the façade.
1-3 Goodge Street is the oldest building in the street (Georgian, built 1763). Internally, it retains many original features, and has a very unusual plan layout - all of which will be lost.

The scheme also involves the redevelopment of the corner building with a replacement which, both in terms of design and materials, is more Las Vegas than Goodge Street!
