The Plan was prepared by residents and businesses after extensive public consultation and after going through a detailed examination process.

Once approved by the referendum, the Plan becomes part of the formal planning process and is used to determine planning applications. It will also be useful in persuading the Council and other bodies to carry out improvements to the area.

We want to see Fitzrovia West continue to thrive as an area of mixed uses with a diverse population and with a range of facilities which meet the needs of all those who live, work or visit the area.

WHEN IS THE REFERENDUM?

The referendum is on **Thursday 2nd September**. All residents on the electoral roll can vote as can one person from each business in the area paying business rates.

You can vote in person at the Fitzrovia Centre, 2 Foley Street, or by applying for a postal or proxy vote. Make sure of your vote by downloading a form from <https://www.westminster.gov.uk/about-council/democracy/postal-and-proxy-voting>

The form should be returned to electoralservices@westminster.gov.uk by **17 August**.

Businesses will be mailed further information about voting by Westminster City Council and must register by **29 July**.
