Dear Fitzrovia News

My name is Fran, I am from the Camden Film office. I am writing to notify you of the proposed filming activity which is due to take place in the Fitzrovia area at the beginning of May 2022.

The production, 'Our Man From Jersey' which is a new Netflix action film, they are planning to film inside of the Bay Leaf Café as well as some scenes outside of the café. To facilitate this they have requested a road closure on a section of Tottenham Street and Whitfield Street.

The shoot details are as follows

Shoot Date/Time: 4th May 08:00-20:00

Prep/Strike: 3rd May 08:00-18:00

5th & 6th May 08:00-18:00

Some preparatory works will begin towards the end of this week inside the café and wrap up works will take place on the two days after the shoot. This will be a considerably small unit and should not cause any disturbance.

Crew size: 100

Road closure: 1 day - emergency and pedestrian access maintained fully throughout

Shoot Details: Filming interior and exterior scenes of the Bay Leaf Cafe on Tottenham Street, including a vehicle driving on Whitfield Street which pulls up and actors get out before walking into cafe.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times and the production will have marshals on hand to advise throughout the shoot.

The productions parking has been reduced to essential clearance for shot and technical vehicles only. They have requested suspensions on Charlotte Street, Whitfield Street, Chitty Street, Scala Street, and Fitzroy Street. As well as alternative parking being offered to residents via the Parking department, the production has also sourced a private alternative car park for any residents to use nearby if necessary. I believe some of the suspension signs for this shoot have gone up already and we apologise again that these were in place before we could notify you of all the productions plans.

The production is in contact with the business which may be affected by the shoot and letter drop is being carried out in the area.

There is some other filming planning to take place in Fitzroy Square during this week too. Some of this filming is by the same production Our Man From Jersey and some is by another production Damage. We have been working with both productions to coordinate their presence with each other. Please see the proposed schedule below

Our Man From Jersey Prep: Wednesday 4th May: 08:00 – 18:00

Our Man From Jersey Filming: Thursday 5th May: 08:00 – 20:00

Damage Filming: Friday 6th May: 12:00 - 19:00

Our Man From Jersey Reinstatement: Friday 6th May: 08:00 – 18:00

To facilitate this filming, they plan to have suspended bays in the surrounding area located on Warren Street, Conway Street, Grafton Way, Cleveland Street, Fitzroy Street & Charlotte Street. The majority of suspensions are for clearance of shot whilst they are filming on 5th and 6th May but some are for technical support trucks / vans containing our filming equipment.

The filming on 5th May will have traffic controls in place. These will be temporary traffic holds of up to 3 minutes when the cameras are rolling. Access to properties will be maintained at all times as well as emergency access.

The filming on 6th May is interiors only and will only have the suspension to help facilitate their shoot.

Again both of these productions will be letter dropping the area to make residents aware of their filming plans.

Local support is hugely important to us and we aim to work with the production to make sure as little disturbance is caused as possible. If you have any concerns or further questions about the plans outlined here please do not hesitate to contact us.
