Crabtree Fields – Landscaping works

We're delighted to announce that Ginkgo Gardens have now been appointed by Camden Council as the contractor responsible for delivering the green space improvements and restoration work at Crabtree Fields.

Works will commence Monday 14th April 2025 and we expect to finish late-August 2025. Ginkgo Gardens will have a full-time presence throughout the project. Immediate work will include closing off the park for public use and securing the site using fencing along Whitfield Street and Colville Place.

Important information

- Crabtree Fields will be closed for the duration of the works. During this period we want to make sure that residents and users of the space still have access to good quality green space. Don't forget, Alfred Place and The Warren are both a short walk from Crabtree Fields. Both parks are great spaces for children to play, to sit and enjoy nature and find some shade as we enter the summer months.
