I am writing to invite you to an online briefing and drop-in session on **Find Fitzrovia** and plans for the **London Festival of Architecture 2026**.

The London Festival of Architecture is a month-long programme of events and activities taking place across London. The 2026 festival will run from **1 to 30 June 2026** and is centred on the theme of **Belonging**. It offers an opportunity to test new ideas, bring partners together, and celebrate the places, people and stories that shape London's neighbourhoods.

For The Fitzrovia Partnership, this provides a strong platform for our work around celebrating Fitzrovia as a destination. Through 'Find Fitzrovia', we are looking at how we can strengthen Fitzrovia's identity, improve legibility across the district, and encourage more people to explore the area and spend time here. We want to help better connect the neighbourhood, celebrate what makes Fitzrovia distinct, and support local businesses, cultural organisations and residents.

Our proposed activity for 2026 will build on this direction and form part of our contribution to the London Festival of Architecture, with Fitzrovia identified as one of the festival's destinations.
